

MIR Resident Call Structure

FIRST YEAR SHIFTS

- Saturday section shifts (neuro, US, CT, chest, etc)
 - Duties: normal weekday workflow – attending is with you the whole time
 - Typical hours: 7 AM-12 PM
 - Average # per year: 14

SECOND YEAR SHIFTS

- Saturday section shifts
 - As described above
 - Average # per year: 8-10
- “B1” shifts
 - Duties:
 - ED plain films
 - Answering phone calls and protocoling studies
 - Respond to all contrast reactions
 - Typical hours:
 - Weekdays: 5-9 PM
 - Saturday: 12 – 9 PM
 - Sunday (two shifts):
 - 8 AM – 5 PM
 - 5 PM – 9 PM
 - Average # per year: 24 total (12 weekends)
- Night Float
 - Duties:
 - Pediatric shift:
 - All ED and inpatient pediatric studies, except neuro MRI
 - Duties of “B1” starting at 9 PM
 - Adult shift:
 - All ED and inpatient CT studies
 - Any ED or inpatient ultrasound or nuclear medicine studies
 - Typical hours:
 - Pediatric shift: 5 PM – 8 AM
 - Adult shift: 7 PM – 9 AM
 - Average # per year: 4 weeks in two separate 2 week blocks (2 nights on followed by 1 night off)
- “BDay” shift
 - Duties: same as adult night float
 - Typical hours: Saturday 12 – 5 PM
 - Average # per year: 1
- Pediatric Long
 - Duties: same as pediatric night float
 - Typical hours: 8 AM – 5 PM
 - Average # per year: 1

**THIRD YEAR
SHIFTS**

- Saturday section shifts
 - As described above
 - Average # per year: 3
- Night Float
 - As described above
 - Average # per year: 4 weeks in two separate 2 week blocks
- “BDay” shift
 - As described above
 - Average # per year: 2-3
- Pediatric long
 - As described above
 - Average # per year: 2-3

**FOURTH
YEAR SHIFTS**

- Saturday section shifts
 - As described above
 - Average # per year: 3-4
- SNF shifts
 - Duties: same as adult night float
 - Typical hours:
 - Monday-Saturday: 5 PM – 9 AM
 - Stay until list caught up (average around midnight) and then can go upstairs to sleep before returning in the morning for readout
 - Day after shift is off
 - Sunday (two shifts):
 - 8 AM – 5 PM
 - 12 PM – 9 AM
 - Average # per year: 28 (14 weekends)
