The purpose of these funds is to provide seed money to test new ideas in the preliminary stages before enough data has been gathered to submit a proposal for external funding.

Things to consider before filling out request for funds:

- Impact of proposed work may have on the field
- Potential to obtain future funding
- Project design and procedures
